We would like to advise residents that there is a snow removal policy in place with the following priorities: Priority 1: 54 Ave-emergency route. 50 Street from 50 Ave to 54 Ave. Priority 2: 50 Ave, 52 Street from 50 Ave. to 54 Ave., 51 Avenue. Priority 3: All remaining streets and avenues – alleys and lanes. Should another snowfall occur before all streets are fully clear, plowing operations will start again with Priority 1.
